**Public transport:**

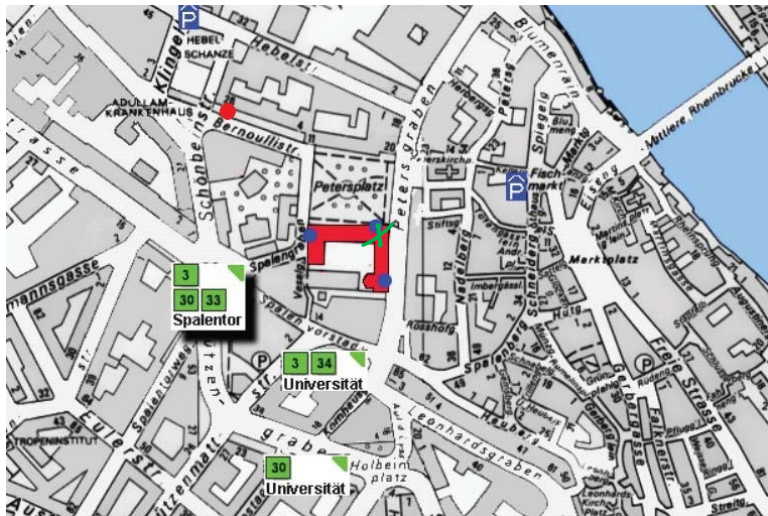

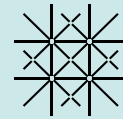
